Who Can Attend:

All children who are at least 5 years of age and no more than 10 years of age before his or her first day of summer day camp on June 3, 2025.

Campers must be able to function in a group setting and be able to participate in all camp activities.

Camp t-shirts are by pre-order only and are an additional \$10 (shirts orders are due by May 23, 2025). Camp shirts are the same at all 3 locations.



Summer Camp Rules

All camp rules are for your safety and the safety of others.

Please follow the guidelines and rules at all times.

Parents must sign campers in camp and out of camp daily.

Campers can only leave with parents or names of individuals which have been given written permission by parents to pick up campers.

Campers need to wear comfortable clothing, tennis shoes or closed back sandals every day

Do not bring valuables to camp (phones, money, etc.)

Each camper is to remain with his or her camp leader until a parent or an authorized person arrives.

Any other arrangement for campers must be made in advance with the Camp Director in written form for verification.

Summer Camp Rules

Always act appropriately:

Always tell the truth.

**Inappropriate language (i.e. profanity)
will not be tolerated.**

Be nice to others, no negative comments or put-downs.

Respect other people.

**Keep your hands to yourself, hitting, pushing or
shoving will not be tolerated.**

Respect other people's property.

Take care of camp equipment and camp building.

Campers should not touch other camper's food.

**Campers are to follow all the directions
of their camp leader.**



Summer Camp Rules

**Camp hours are 8:00 am – 3:30 pm
Campers cannot be dropped off before 8:00am
Camp ends at 3:30 pm sharp!**

A late pick-up fee will be charged at the following rate:

3:31–3:45 pm	\$15
3:46–4:00 pm	\$30
4:01–4:15 pm	\$45
4:16–4:30 pm	\$60

This policy is strictly enforced and your child will not be allowed to return to camp until the late fees are paid.

At 4:30 when a camper has not been picked up, the Camp Director will attempt to contact the parent or individuals on the designated emergency contact list.

If no one can be reached or arrives, the Camp Director will call local law enforcement agencies or child protective services.



Summer Camp Rules

SUMMER CAMPER MISBEHAVIOR POLICY

WBR Summer Camp is created with consideration for content, pace, transitioning, and activity diversity to minimize causes for camper misbehavior.

Parents/Guardians are responsible for working with summer camp staff to resolve any unwanted behaviors.

Upon the severity of the unwanted behaviors, a camper may:

- **Be given friendly verbal reminders**
 - **Be redirected**
 - **Be given a timeout**
 - **Have an activity taken away**
- **Be sent home for the remainder of the day**
- **Be dismissed from the remainder of camp sessions**



Summer Camp Rules

BULLYING

Bullying is defined as an intentional, repeated act meant to harm another person physically, emotionally, or through exclusion via in-person interaction, digital communication, or virtual mediums that staff and campers interact on during WBR Summer Camp.

Bullying will not be tolerated by any means from anyone.

WBR Summer Camp Director reserves the right to dismiss any camper, whose conduct or influence is unsatisfactory or detrimental to the best interests of the camp.

Dismissal from camp is determined entirely at the discretion of WBR Summer Camp Director.

If needed, Parent/Guardian will be required to pick up the camper immediately upon being notified of the camper being sent home or expelled from camp.
